

IMPORTANT NOTICE ABOUT FISHING

It's up to you to make sure you have a valid rod licence. Whether you fish on private fisheries or on a campsite rally. Anyone age 12 or over must have an environment agency rod licence. They are available from post office outlets though out England & Wales, also on line, direct debt and over the phone on 0844 80105386. A rod licence runs from 1st April until 31st March each year.

Anglers under the age of 12 DO NOT NEED A LICENCE TO GO FISHING but THEY MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT WHO HAS A VALID ROD LICENCE.

Be Warned

It is an offence to fish for freshwater fish and eels without a valid rod licence and if you are caught you may be fined up to £2,500.

On top of your yearly licence you may need to purchase a day ticket, which varies from venue to venue. Check bank-side rules.

And finally always read the banks side rules and obey them, as you can be thrown off if you are caught breaking them.
